Our Care Coordinator volunteers meet with shelter residents weekly. An assessment of residents' internal strengths and weaknesses as well as extrinsic opportunities for success and threats to that success is completed at the initial meeting. With that information, volunteers assist residents in casting a vision for their future and in setting measurable, objective goals to guide toward that vision. In subsequent weekly meetings, the Care Coordinator volunteer assesses residents' progress and assists in setting new goals for continued growth.

Our goal is to engage residents relationally, responsibly, and compassionately while assisting them in improving their connection, character and career opportunities.
